

Narcotics

The procurement of Narcotics requires a license with the New York State Department of Health (NYSDOH) and a registration from the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA).

End User/Unit/BSC:

It is the end user's responsibility to obtain a license and registration appropriate for the anticipated use of controlled substances. Usage of another licensee/registrant number for procurement is not allowed. Each requisition for controlled substances (Narcotics) must be accompanied by a properly prepared DEA form (dependent on the drug schedule) signed by the registration holder. If the vendor does not currently have a current copy of the registration and license, then a copy must accompany the requisition. The vendor will not ship the items without a copy of the license and registration on file. Contact Environment, Health and Safety (EHS) before purchasing to assist in procurement of Narcotics.
